Altar serving at St. Mary parish is open to any parish youth enrolled in faith formation, Catholic school, or home schooled, 4th grade and older, who have made their first Reconciliation and Holy Communion. They should have a desire to grow in their faith, learn more about the mass, and serve God and the Church. Servers need to be supported by their families so that they can come to mass regularly and fulfill their commitments.
