**Returning Catholics** (*With team, welcome those returning to the church*)

**Sunday Scripture Discussion**

**I pray for others and have compassion for the sick and elderly. God may be calling me to:**

**Eucharistic Adoration** (*Pray for a 1/2 hour or hour every Tuesday before the Blessed Sacrament for self, our parish and others*)

**Home Bound Ministry** (*Call, visit and bring the Eucharist to shut-ins*) **Pray for Others** (*As requested through the parish office*)

**I enjoy rallying people to a cause, working with others to find the best solution to world problems, and prefer lively activity to quiet and solitude. God may be calling me to:**

**Housing and Shelter Programs** (*Habitat for Humanity-summer build*)

**St. Vincent/Service** (*Projects to meet and help the poor, hungry, homeless, etc.*)

**Peace and Justice** (*Advocate for life, poor, homeless, human rights, sustainable environments*)

**Respect LIFE Activities** (*Advocating for all stages of life*)

**Jail and Prison Ministry** (*Assist with prayer services, visit or write letters*)

**I am good at starting conversations and keeping them going. God may be calling me to:**

**RCIA Team Helper** (*Weekly discussions with adults, teens or children*)

**I am skilled at working with computers and technology. God may be calling me to:**

**Tech Team** (*Computer and network maintenance, web development, technology planning, etc.*)

**I enjoy cooking. Food is nourishment for the body, just as scripture is nourishment for the soul. God may be calling me to:**

**GOD WORKS!** *(As a team member, prepare and serve a warm meal 3 to 4 times a year on a Friday evening)*

**Soup/Salad Luncheons** *(First Wednesday of the months of September through May and all Wednesdays during Lent)*

**One of my favorite ways to pray is to sing or play a musical instrument and I want to contribute to the joy of liturgical celebrations. God may be calling me to:**

**Parish Choir 9:30 a.m.** *(Traditional choral music, teens and adults)*

**Resurrection Choir** *(Sing at parish funerals)*

**Hand bell Choirs** *(Bell and chime music; middle school through adult)*

**Instrumentalist** *(Minister as an instrumentalist during Masses)*

**Cantor** *(a person trained to sing solo verses or passages to which the choir or congregation responds )*

**I believe in the power of our young people to change the world. Acting as a teacher and/or mentor for our youth through school, religious education, and or/leadership programs is meaningful to me. God may be calling me to:**

**Faith Formation Early Childhood Catechist** *(Catechesis of the Good Shepherd at 9:30 a.m. Mass)*

**Faith Formation Catechist; Grades 1-8** *(Sunday, 11:00 - 12:15 p.m., September through April)*

**Classroom Aides; Grades 1 - 8** *(Help catechist as needed with the work of teaching)*

**Special Needs Volunteers** *(Assist individuals with special learning needs during scheduled sessions on Saturday mornings, 10 - Noon, September through May)*

**Children's Liturgy of the Word** *(On a rotating basis, proclaim the Gospel to children during the 9:30 mass in the Social Hall)*

**Vacation Bible Adventure** *(Lead or assist in the one-week summer program)* **Youth Ministry** *(Leaders and assistants for ministry to high school teens)*

**I enjoy working with my hands and taking care of details. God may be calling me to:**

**Faith Formation Office Volunteer** *(Sunday office help, 10 - 12:30 p.m.)*

**Bulletin Insert Team** *(Occasional Friday mornings for approximately one hour)*

**Sewing** *(RCIA garments and banners)*

**Prayer Shawl Ministry** *(Knit or crochet shawls for parishioners experiencing challenges)*

**Art and Design** *(Periodically help decorate the church. An artistic eye is helpful but not required. Guidance is provided)*

**Altar and Church Care/Christian Women** *(Help with cleaning sanctuary, sacristy and linens)*

**St. Fiacre Gardeners** *(Help keep parish grounds beautiful. Plant flowers and weeding from May to October)*

**Rosary Makers** *(Meets every Tuesday, September through June, 9 - 11 a.m. in the Social Hall)*

**I like planning and participating in social and community activities. God may be calling me to:**
